



AGRICULTURE

Scope, objective and dedication of Agricultural Education in India

Agriculture can be defined as the art, science, and business of cultivating crops and livestock for economicu purposes. At certain stages of human development, agriculture is used to be the only known means of living.



It is derived from the Latin terms ager referring to the soil and cultura to its cultivation. Agriculture is a broad term encompassing all aspects of crop production, horticulture, livestock farming, forestry etc.

Agriculture is a production plant where the free gifts of nature such as land, water, air, soil energy, etc. are used as inputs and then converted into a single primary unit that is crop plants and their yield which are indispensable for human beings. Those primary units are consumed by animals and are converted into secondary units like milk, meat, eggs, wool, honey, silk, etc.

PROVIDES EMPLOYMENT

Agriculture has the contribution of 16% in the gross domestic product (GDP) of the country. The agricultural sector also provides livelihood to two-thirds of the population. The agricultural sector is responsible for the employment of 58% of country's workforce.

SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION IN COUNTRIES EXPORT

This sector accounts for about 15% of the total export earnings and prov,,,, ides raw material to almost all the industries i.e. textiles, silk, rice, rubber, paper, flour mills, milk products industries.

AN IMPORTANT SOURCE OF RESOURCE MOBILIZATION

As the people in rural areas are not very rich, it proves as one of the biggest markets for low-priced consumer goods.


BETTER THE AGRICULTURE BETTER THE FOOD SECURITY IN THE COUNTRY

FARMERS PROTEST

Everything that the Government does these days is hailed as 'historic'. But will the 'historic' farm reforms turn into historic blunders like the earlier protests?



The distrust for the Government is such that farmers are unwilling to accept their assurances at face value. The government has claimed that the opposition have been misleading the nation on farm bills: that its heart bleeds for farmers and our Government will never do away with the Minimum Support Price (MSP) regime. The fact is that the three ordinances, now approved by Parliament without much scrutiny, do not make any mention of doing away with the MSP or procurement of foodgrains by the Government

But farmers, still waiting to see their income double by 2022 as promised by the government, and are demanding MSP to be made into a legal right. It is fine for the government to say that farmers are now free to sell their produce anywhere and at whatever price they like to anyone. But can the Government guarantee that prices will not tumble, that private corporate bodies and traders will not form a cartel and squeeze the farmers? And if the government is so sincere about giving farmers higher prices, why not make it a law that prices for agriculture produce cannot be lower than MSP determined by 4the Government? Whether it will be concluded or continued till their souls goes off...????

FARMER BILL 2020 CHALLENGES

Agriculture, a major occupation and a Primary source of Income for our country is now slowly vanishing. In order to protect the farmers and enable them to get a fair price for their hard work, The Farm Bill, 2020 is passed. A group of Farmers are agitating against it, as it is not good for them.

PROS

- The farmers had moved towards free and more flexible system.
- 2. Selling outside the Physical territory of the mantis, will be additional marketing channel for the farmers.
- The farmer or producer is given the same attention as production.

CONS

- 1. It hampers with the monopoly of Agricultural Produce Market committee mantis, thereby allowing sale Purchase sale of crop outside.
- 2. Bill doesn't give any statutory backing to MSP
- The government declares MSP for crops, but there has been no law mandating its iplementation.

SCHEME



PM Modi releases over Rs 18,000 crore to more than nine crore farmers under PM-KISAN scheme



New Delhi, Dec 25 () Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday released over Rs 18,000 crore to more than nine crore farmer families under the 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi' (PM-KISAN). With the push of a button. Modi enabled the transfer of money at an event which the ruling BJP has made into a mega exercise to reach out to farmers by having its leaders interact with the farming community at more than 19 000 venues across the country and also listen to the prime minister's address

Did you know?

Modi released the instalment of Rs 2,000 to every farmer on the birth anniversary of former prime minister and BJP Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, which is every year celebrated as "Good Governance Day" by the ruling party.





Under the PM-KISAN scheme, a financial benefit of Rs 6,000 per year is provided to small and marginal farmers, payable in three equal instalments of Rs 2,000 each. The fund is transferred directly to the bank accounts of the beneficiaries.

The programme comes amid protests by various farmer unions against three farm laws recently enacted by the Modi government. His government has insisted that these reforms are in the interest of farmers.



Terrace Gardening

The long period of COVID-19 lockdown may have brought most of the activities to a standstill, but it has certainly helped in reviving several terrace gardens in Bengaluru. Some residents have taken to terrace gardening either to beat the boredom or to make the best use of leisure time.



"Thousands of terrace gardens in Bengaluru had been left unattended due to their busy schedule. Now, the lockdown has provided them an opportunity to revive them. According to different estimates reaching us, anywhere from 5,000 to 10,000 of them have been revived so far," says Dr. C. Aswath, Principal Scientist and head of the Indian Institute of Horticultural Research's (IIHR) Division of Floriculture and Medicinal Plants. Freshers too are taking to terrace gardening during the lockdown, he adds.

5,000 to 10,000 terrace gardens are estimated to have been revived in Bengaluru during lockdown




GREEN NEWSPAPER

You have enormous wisdom within. It is a matter of making the connection with this inherent wisdom and trusting yourself to do what is right for you at any given time.




#5 - Do it together
